

Modification to the Methodology of the S&P 500 Low Volatility, S&P MidCap 400 Low Volatility, and S&P SmallCap 600 Low Volatility Indices

NEW YORK, APRIL 27, 2020: S&P Dow Jones Indices (“S&P DJI”) announces the following methodology change to the S&P 500 Low Volatility, S&P MidCap 400 Low Volatility, and S&P SmallCap 600 Low Volatility Indices.

	Previous	Updated
Rebalancing – Reference Price for Calculation of Index Shares	Constituents’ shares are calculated using closing prices on the second Friday of the rebalancing month as the reference price.	Index shares are calculated using closing prices on the Wednesday prior to the second Friday of the rebalancing month as the reference price.

This change will become effective prior to the market open on **Thursday, April 30, 2020**.
