

S&P Eurozone Automotive and Electric Vehicles Index Eligibility Criteria Modifications

NEW YORK, NOVEMBER 9, 2023: S&P Dow Jones Indices (“S&P DJI”) announces changes to the S&P Eurozone Automotive and Electric Vehicles Index.

To align with other thematic indices, S&P DJI is modifying the multiple share class approach and adding a buffer to the current FMC threshold.

IMPLEMENTATION TIMING

S&P DJI will implement the previously described methodology changes as part of a one-time ad-hoc reweighting, which will also take into account the change to the Multiple Share Class approach. This reweighting will take place prior to the market open on **Monday, December 18, 2023**. The changes will first be visible to clients in pro-forma files beginning on **Friday, December 8, 2023**.

Please note that the S&P Thematic Indices Methodology on S&P DJI’s website is being updated to reflect these changes.
