The table below summarizes the changes.

Brazil – ETF	0	10
Costa Rica	30	15
Lithuania	15	16
Malawi	15	10
Turkey	10	15

The changes for Brazil – ETF, Costa Rica, Lithuania, Malawi, and Turkey will become effective prior to the market open on Wednesday, January 01, 2025.
